The Gamma Eta Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated is pleased to announce that we are accepting applications for program designed for local female high school seniors graduating in May of 2019.

Our chapter will award six, one-time awards, valued at \$1000 each, at our annual scholarship program. In addition, the Audrey Daste LeBlanc Memorial Scholarship, a \$500 award for a female student that plans to attend Southern University (Baton Rouge campus), will also be awarded. The Jo Ethel Honoré Memorial Scholarship, a \$500 scholarship, will also be awarded to a student that is graduating from Scotlandville High School.

Qualified applicants are those students who will:

- Be a female high school senior graduating in May 2019 from a school in East Baton Rouge parish
- Plan to pursue a baccalaureate degree
- Provide verification that all End of Year courses (EOC) have been successfully completed
- Possess a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- Participate in the essay writing competition
- Submit the scholarship application, head shot photograph, seven semester high school transcript, one-page resume, and a copy of ACT scores

The scholarship program will commence with an essay competition that will take place at the Gamma Eta Omega Sorority House located at 1605 Harding Boulevard in Baton Rouge. The competition will take place on Thursday, March 14, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. and will require applicants to compose an original essay on a specific topic while at the sorority house. Essays will be scored and added to the students' application packet.

Attached to this letter is a copy of scholarship application. We will accept no more than two (2) applicants from each high school.
